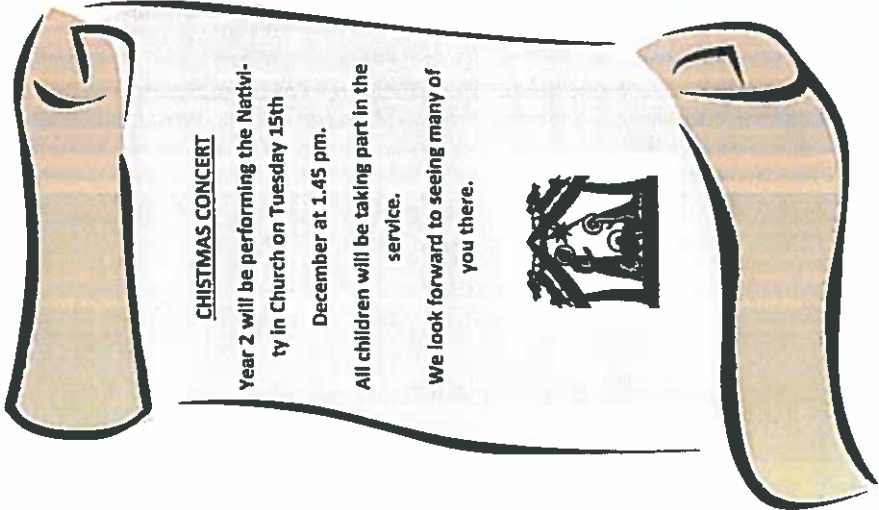


CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY
