
# **English Tasks**

### Task 1: Book talk

Listen to the story and discuss and answer the following questions;

Who are the characters in the story?

What kind of character is the lonely Beast – is he kind, unkind? How do you know this?

Where is setting of the story? (There might be more than one in this particular story)

What happens at the beginning of the story?

What happens in the middle of the story?

How does the story end?



## **Task 2: Describing the Beast**





Adjectives can be identified easily through our 5 senses; how something looks, sounds, feels, smells and tastes. You can also find adjectives by thinking about the size and colour of the noun.

For this task, can you draw a picture of the Lonely Beast and find adjectives to decribe him. Uase your 5 senses to write short sentences. E.g

The Lonely Beast looks big and furry.

The Lonely Beast sounds loud.

The Lonely Beast feels soft

Say your sentence out loud first;

Start your sentence with a captial letter;

Include finger spaces;

Use your phonics to write the words;

Finish your sentence with a full stop;

Read your sentence to check it makes sense.
