





The Storm Whale - Benji Davies


We are starting a new book called 'The Storm Whale'. This week, we will write a letter of advice to Noi.

Now that Noi has found the baby whale, how do you think he is feeling?




Let's remind ourselves of how Noi was feeling beore he saw the whale in the picture below;




We decided he was feeling nervous, scared and lonely. Is he still feeling that way?


