<p><b>Spelling and handwriting</b></p> 	<p><b>Spelling</b> –practise using a strategy from the spelling strategy sheet. <b>This week practise spellings words with /k/ sound written as 'ch'</b></p> <p>scheme    chorus            echo            character    ache</p> <p>stomach    chemistry orchestra    technology    chaos</p> <p>Your parent can test you on Friday like we do in class. Remember to keep practising any words you misspell. <p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p><b>Telling the time</b> <b>Practise:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• continue learning to read the time reading to nearest 5 minutes and converting between analogue and digital</li> <li>• Tell the time using a.m. or p.m. think about and notice what time of the day do you do certain activities.</li> </ul> <p><b>See activities and teaching slides for a.m. and p.m. on Year 3 google drive.</b> As always revise your 2, 3, 4 and 8 times table. Use the Times Table Rockstar website.</p>
<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p><b>Descriptive writing:</b></p> <p>1) Describe a photo (<b>There is an activity sheet on Year 3 google drive or you can use a photo from home/ a magazine etc etc</b>) use your 5 senses to describe what you can see/hear/smell/ taste etc. Use figurative language e.g. noun phrases, similes, metaphors etc</p> <p>2) Fiction Comprehension activity - 'The happy hunter and the skilful fisher' read and complete the questions <b>See activities and teaching slides on Year 3 google drive.</b></p>
<p><b>Reading</b></p> 	<p>You should be reading for at least 10-15 minutes every evening. <b>Read this week's Ebook is 'The tale of Peter Rabbit' read with your adult: Adult please sign your child's reading record once they have read it.</b> <b>Follow up questions to discuss:</b></p> <p>1) Recall- who were the characters in the story? Who was the main character? How do you know?</p> <p>2) Discuss - Is this text similar to any you have read before? <b>*The book can be found on the Year 3 google drive.</b></p>
<p><b>Music</b></p>	<p>Practise notes B, A, G, D, C, F and E on the recorder (especially F and E). Remember to cover the holes so that there are no squeaks, blow softly and whisper "do do do". Practise It's Raining, Dear Liza and Old McDonald Had a Farm. Remember, your practise book shows you how to read and play the notes on page 4. Create your own pieces using the notes you have learnt.</p>
