

Topic Science 	<p>Parts of a plant and their function</p> <p>Last week we looked at the different parts of a plant. Then, in your own words, explain what the job/function of each part is.</p>  <p>The diagram illustrates a sunflower plant with labels for its key parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> flower: The flower makes seeds for the plant. leaves: Leaves make food for the plant. They take in carbon dioxide and release oxygen into the air. stem: The stem supports the plant. It contains thin tubes for carrying food, minerals, and water through the plant. roots: The roots soak up water and minerals. They also store food for the plant.
